Appearance and jewellery:

The school does not permit children to have ANY haircuts that could serve as a distraction to other children. This includes **conspicuous markings e.g. tramlines and Mohicans, or Mohican like styles**. **No colours** or styles which would be considered as extreme are allowed and **no extreme graduation of cut and hair length across the hair**. We strongly advise that parents/carers check with school before they get their child's hair cut if they are unsure in anyway as staff are always happy to help.

Large JoJo bands and large Headbands are not allowed as they can also be a distraction to other children. We advise and promote that **simple and small hair accessories are worn to match the school colours.**

Make-up and nail varnish are <u>not</u> allowed.

Earrings are **not** permitted on the grounds of Health and Safety. No other jewellery apart from wrist watches are allowed.
