### Unit Scripture

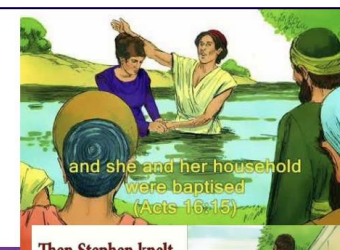
“Jesus said ‘you are witnesses to these things’”
